The Oliver Soil Conservation District annually awards a \$750 scholarship to a graduating high school senior who writes the best essay on the selected topics.

2025 Topics

(Select One)

1. What is the importance of Soil Health and how does it affect your everyday life?
2. How does water quality affect plants, animals, and humans?

ELGIBILITY:

1. Must be a resident of Oliver County.
2. Must be a graduating senior in the spring of 2025.
3. Must be an essay of at least 500 but not more than 1000 words.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1. Correct grammar, spelling and punctuation are critical.
2. Factual accuracy.
 - a. Display a command of the facts relating to the selected topic.
3. Originality and creativity.
 - a. Communicate a personal experience or connection to the topic.
4. Overall knowledge of the topic.
 - a. Demonstrate a breadth of topic knowledge
5. Plagiarism will result in disqualification.
6. Must meet the April 30th, 2025, deadline.

AWARDING OF SCHOLARSHIP:

Applicants will need to maintain at least a 2.5 GPA and be a full-time student. Scholarship will be paid after the Soil District receives the previous semester's transcript
