CLASSROOM RULES

- 1. When someone else is talking you are not. **Respect** other people in the class.
- 2. **Cell phones** will be put in the numbered pouch at the beginning of class. If you refuse to put your cell phone in the pouch, the principal and dean of students will be informed and there will be appropriate consequences. Cell phones may be allowed when needed for class and then Mrs. Smith will give you permission to use them.

- 9. If a student's Internet **access is revoked** for a violation of the Acceptable Use Policy, if internet is required for the assignment, the student will have to complete their assignments outside the school or receive 0's.
