*No student in grades 9-12 should pay more than \$120 in user fees, and no student in grades 7-8 should pay more than \$90 in user fees. Note: These maximums apply to user fees only and do not include activity tickets. Activity Tickets are no longer included in the user fee and must be purchased separately.

Students will be charged a \$25 user fee for the following activities: Cheerleading, Drill Team, FFA, FBLA, FCCLA, Drama, and Speech.

High school students, (9-12), will be charged a \$60 user fee for the following sports: Cross

Country, Girls' Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Boys' Basketball, Golf, Track, and Wrestling.

Grades 7 and 8 will be charged a \$45 user fee for the following sports: Cross Country, Girls' Basketball, Football, Volleyball, Boys' Basketball, Golf, Track, and Wrestling.

Baseball will be determined in the spring of the year.

Students in vocational classes must pay for any projects prior to taking them home.

Students will be assessed replacement costs for any equipment or books that are assigned to them during the school year if they are lost or damaged. The school is not responsible for lost personal articles belonging to students.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

Students in grades 6-8 will register at the middle school on August 15, 2023 from 8AM to 3PM.
